

## **Construction updates**

#### Our work on Phase 1 is progressing well. Find out more about our construction works below:



Structural works are complete for the two pedestrian bridges, with brickwork, lighting and other electrical works now being installed.



Parking suspension on Cranberry Lane will remain in place to provide safe access for works on the Stephenson Street bridge.



There will be occasional night shifts during the week from **12 midnight - 5am** for additional works on the Stephenson Street bridge.





Footpath closure will remain in place near the Southern pedestrian bridge so that works can continue safely.



Traffic management remains in place along Manor Road to facilitate safe crossings, with lane closures mid-week from **7pm -11pm** for deliveries to collect materials and equipment.

## Visit to Gainsborough Primary School

The TwelveTrees Park team recently went to Gainsborough Primary School to talk to the pupils about the different roles in the construction industry to get them thinking about different careers. It was great to talk to over 120 of the children there and we hope to see some of them in the industry in the years to come!
